What happened between here: Lot dwelt in the cities of the plain and pitched *his* tent even as far as Sodom. Gen 13:12 (NKJV) and here: Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom.? Gen 19:1 (NKJV)

How did Lot get from the plains to the city? When he first chose to go that direction, the well watered plains had gotten his attention. But by chapter 19 we find he is no longer in a tent but living in a house in the city of Sodom. Did Lot think that he wouldn't be affected by close proximity to the sinful life of Sodom? Was he hoping to gain some reputation by rubbing elbows with the elders of the city? Was he willing to take the risk so that he and his family could enjoy more elaborate lodging than a tent of the desert? I really don't know.

I do know that I need to be cautious about making the same mistake. Regardless of how inviting it may appear, I must resist the danger of drifting toward sin. Earthly fame is nothing compared to being known as a child of God. The mansion that I seek must be the one in Heaven.
