*Psalms 23:4 (NKJV) Yea, though I walk
through the valley of the shadow of death, I
will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod
and Your staff, they comfort me.*

I realize that the Twenty-third Psalm is a tremendous source of encouragement at times of death. I have often recited it at graveside services. But have you ever considered that the phrase "walk through the valley of the shadow of death" is encouraging in other situations? 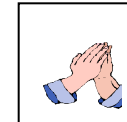
