Here is a part of the message that Paul delivered to the persecuted Thessalonians: *in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.* 2 Thess. 1:8 (NKJV) He is describing the return of Christ by reminding these Christians that vengeance upon the unrighteous will be enforced by the Lord and commends them for believing the gospel he had preached.

What I want to notice is that the unbelievers are those who did not obey the gospel message. Believing requires obedience. If we truly know God, then we know that He requires obedience. This certainly does not agree with those who teach there is nothing to do but believe.

Bible study starts at 6:30 PM.




