SALVATION BY BAPTISM ONLY?

You have to get baptized! Although this statement is absolutely true, I believe that we can fall into a practice of teaching "baptism only" for salvation. Just as some have developed tunnel vision concerning faith and grace, we can become so centered upon baptism that we make a similar mistake. Paul tells us that our preaching should center upon Christ: "*but we preach Christ crucified*" (1 Cor. 1:23a). Baptism is certainly an important part of the story but it is not the only part. Belief in Jesus and His message, turning away from sin, and an acknowledgement of Him as the Son of God is necessary. We must teach that a faithful life is required afterward. We cannot allow our eagerness for conversion to prompt a short-cutting of the message.


