After the healing of the lame man by Peter and John (Acts 4), the Sanhedrin commanded them to stop preaching Jesus. They answered with a statement that still challenges many today: *Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge.* Acts 4:19 (NKJV)
