'God Created In Six Days'

"In the beginning God created the Heavens and earth." (Gen. 1:1). "Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day." (Gen. 1:31). "Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished. And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done." (Gen. 2:1-2).

Since God's Word (the Bible) is truth (John 17:17), why have so many been taught and apparently believe that it took millions of years for the earth to have its beginning?

Some have said: "It wasn't actual six days, but each so-called day was really millions of years long." But notice what the Word of God says— "So the evening and morning were the first day"; and on through the sixth day. Evening, morning add up to 24 hours.

Notice the words God gave through Moses to the Israelites, which were God's special people about 1500 years.

"Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do your work, but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord your God. In it you shall do no work.

"FOR IN SIX DAYS the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it." Israel's week was seven days long.

Notice the words of Jesus Christ— "But from the beginning of the creation, God made them male and female." (Mark 10:6). Do you believe the words of our Lord?

Since the human mind cannot figure how God accomplished so much in six days, far too many thus will not believe God's Word. Such people will have a terrible eternal outcome.

Unfortunately, for many years some teachers even in public schools, have been trying to teach our children and grandchildren that the "creation took millions of years". When are Christians going to do something to end this false teaching?

How about you? Do you believe what God says? In order to gain eternal life you must: Hear the Gospel of Christ, Rom. 10:17; Believe the good news about Christ, John 8:24; Repent of your sins, Acts 2:38; Publicly confess Christ, Matt. 10:32-33; Be baptized into Christ, Mark 16:15, Rom. 6:3-5). Live faithfully, Rev. 2:10.
