During the days of Alexander the Great, Phocion had served Athens as a general times without number. Now he had reached old age and was still a poor man. Alexander sent him a present of a hundred talents. When this arrived in Athens, Phocion asked those who brought it why, when there were so many Athenians to choose from, Alexander should have singled out him as the recipient of such a huge sum. They answered, "Because Alexander considers that only you are a good and honorable man." Phocion's reply was, "In that case let him allow me to continue in that state and to enjoy that reputation always."

The messengers followed Phocion to his house and saw his frugal way of life and exclaimed that it was monstrous that an honored friend of the king should live in such poverty.

Phocion caught sight of a poor old man who was walking by dressed in a squalid cloak, and so he asked them which of the two they thought inferior, himself or the old man. They begged him not to make such a comparison, whereupon Phocion replied, "Well, this man has less to live on than I have, and yet he finds it quite enough."

So the treasure went back from whence it came, proving to the Greeks that the man who did not need such a sum was richer than the man who offered it. Later, Alexander offered him the revenue of whichever one of four cities he might choose, and said that he would be vehemently angry if Phocion did not accept the gift. But again Phocion declined.


It seems that somewhere in my Bible I read, "Keep your life free from love of many, and be content with what you have; for he has said, "I will never fail you nor forsake you.""
