Each time I read the historical story associated with Samson I can't help but reflect on his stupidity! Whatever is to be said about Delilah, or any other person in Judges 13-16, it's Samson who plays with fires and gets burned. Delilah sold her dignity and defined her actions as "love" toward Samson, but Samson didn't have the wisdom to see that she was a wolf in sheep's clothing.
