I Desire To Do What Is Right In God's Eyes, But...

Tit 2:11-13 For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, (12) teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, (13) looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ.

Which is more difficult, knowing what God wishes for me to do, or doing that which God desires for me to do? Many will answer by saying, "I know what God expects, but..." What such people face is in actuality a motivational issue. Chapter 2 of Titus is a chapter concerning personal motivation.

The question becomes, "Why should I be motivated, beginning at this very moment, to live the life God desires for me to live?" The apostle Paul answers this question with 3 life-altering answers: #1. We are speaking here of a "now or never" issue. Many declare, "I plan to do better soon!" James 4:14 makes the bold declaration that none of us know with certainty that tomorrow is guaranteed. Therefore, the one who puts off living a godly life is essentially gambling with eternity!

Life-altering fact #2: If you believe in the bible, then you believe that Christ will return. One moment all is as it has ever been, and the next instant finds life as we know it is no more. The question becomes, "Am I
