WHAT WOULD YOU EXPECT IF GOD CAME TO EARTH AS A MAN?

John 9:6-7 When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. (7) And said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which is translated, Sent). So he went and washed and came back seeing.

In today's world it has become difficult to attract anyone's attention, as is evidenced by the outlandish extremes marketers will go to divert our eyes onto their products. What used to be deemed as extreme is by today's standards seen as common-place. However, the miracles of Christ must be considered as being so great that they traverse all generations, affecting the minds and hearts of all who understand the enormity of their implications. What other man of flesh has truthfully made the claim that because of his efforts "the blind receive their sight and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them" (Matthew 11:5)? What more could Jesus had done to convince an unbelieving world? The answer to this question is what separates Christ from mortal men. The resurrection of Jesus, His victory over death, was, and is, witnessed proof that He was God, that he took the form of a servant, and came in the likeness of men. His miracles were performed with a purpose, that we might believe His words. Each of us faces a choice, to accept Christ for whom He is, or to accept ourselves for what we are. If you acknowledge that you cannot save yourself from your sins, then Christ is the answer. His words will judge each of us, words spoken and understood without addition, without subtraction, without modification, and without substitution.
