TO OUR FRIENDS:

The question posed in the title above may indeed be deemed as life's most important to answer correctly. The context of Micah chapter 6 finds God in the midst of a lawsuit against His people. The human response to God's charges can be found in Micah 6:6-7. As one would expect, this response offers a weak defense for the behavior exhibited by many of God's chosen people.

What did God expect of His people 2500 years ago? The answer is the same for us today, "...To do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God." Walking humbly with God means that one walks in submission to Him, not ahead of Him with an air of superiority or beside Him as an equal. King Saul learned this lesson from Samuel in 1 Samuel 15:22, in which God's judge said, "Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice." Our need for humility is easily understood as we read God's words of Psalm 46:10, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!" Our world seems to have forgotten that He is God, and man is not.
